Most people probably agree that it is good to help other people, but how many people do a (①) thing to help people they don't know? This is a true story of a very brave, young girl, Grace Darling.

She was born in a village in England in 1815. The weather was cold there and the sea was often stormy. Her family was not rich, but she lived happily. Her father was *a lighthouse keeper. He always *kept a light burning as a guide for ships which were out at sea at night.

When Grace was ten, the family moved away from the village to one of *the Farne Islands. Her father had to take care of a lighthouse by the sea. Grace could not go to school, but she learned (②) to read and write at home. She also helped her mother, who was always busy cooking, cleaning the rooms, and washing the dishes. It was a simple but happy life.

One dark and very stormy night in September, 1838, a ship traveling from England to Scotland had a problem. Its engine was broken. Because the engine didn't work, the ship *was blown towards the rocks near the Farne Islands. It was damaged and water came into the ship and it began to go down into the sea. About sixty *passengers died. Nine *crew members and one passenger tried to get to the lifeboat, but they couldn't. Five crew and four passengers swam in the cold sea and could only help themselves by *clinging onto some rocks.

Mr. Darling saw what happened and soon went down to the beach to his boat. Grace went with him. They started to *row the boat to help the ship's survivors on the rocks. Her father carried the tired people to the boat while Grace had to control it on the stormy sea. At last, the lucky nine people were in the boat and ③[taken / the lighthouse / to / were / they / back]. Grace and her father took care of them for three days until the end of the storm.

They were very glad to be able to survive. They were ④(surprise) by Grace's brave action on the stormy sea. *Queen Victoria heard about it and wanted to see Grace and her father. They went to London and the Queen gave them a medal.

Sadly, Grace died of sickness in 1842. She was twenty-seven years old. She had a short but wonderful life.

In 1938, the Grace Darling Museum was opened in England. We can see the boat Grace and her father used to help the people on the rocks in 1838. The thing

they did to help other people is still very ⑤(surprise) to everyone in the world.
